I would like to begin by thanking you for the conversation on January 4th and adding me to the mailing list. I am following up on that conversation, my phone message of today, and the latest map posting on the study web site.


As background, in the first public meeting, held in June 2007, one study constraint presented was avoiding planned and plotted developments. I had a contract pending on the purchase of Lot 4 of Lost Canyon Subdivision at that time. This representation factored into consideration when I made the final decision to close on the property.

My concerns are:

1. The Lost Canyon Subdivision is not identified on the Short List Alternative Corridor Map, West C Options that I viewed on the web site today. Segment C1 runs directly through this subdivision and touches 50% of the lots in unit 1.
2. My house, which I have started preliminary phases of construction on, is not marked, as I communicated. Segment C1 runs directly through my construction site. Site coordinates are N29* 46' 45.2" by W098* 06' 01.9". *92,100 5* *lot 29.7792*
3. I am concerned about what may have been omitted from the study efforts to meet the significantly reduced schedule, would you be able to share how this time line reduction was achieved?

In summary, because of these items, I am writing this letter to ensure the study team is aware of the subdivision and have taken its existence into consideration during the planning process.
